Since 1984 Rowan has provided a safe, creative, and enriching environment where the arts are used as a tool to bring people together and tackle social exclusion. Rowan is open Monday to Friday, 9am to 3pm, for 50 weeks a year.

Students can specialise in one area or join a number of different workshops enabling students to develop their individual social and communication skills and participate in a stimulating group experience. Workshops can be attended for full or half days to suit each individual.

Students can choose to work on their own personal projects, on <u>Rowan's commission</u>sor make things to sell such as our popular mindfulness <u>Finger Labyrinths</u>, which we sell across the world! The forest school enables students to be creative and connect with nature. For more details see:
