#### A video by George Williams about free-religion and the 36th Congress of the International Association for Religious Freedom

As the current President of the <u>International Association for Religious Freedom</u> (IARF), <u>George William</u> (with whom Im working to translate <u>the essays of Imaoka Shinichirōsensei</u>) was asked to make a short video talk about its current work promoting <u>free-religion (jiyū</u> <u>shāyō</u> to be shown at the <u>British General Assembly of Unitarian and Free Christian Churches</u> <u>meetings in April 2024</u>.

This 14-minute long video has just gone live on YouTube and you can watch it at the link below. There are two <u>Cambridge Unitarian Church</u>elated bits of content. At 126"a photo appears which shows, in the centre, H. Stewart Carter, who was the minister in Cambridge between 1946-1966 and also a member of the Secretariat of the IARF during the 1950s. The



second appears at 11111"where my own work with the Cambridge community gets a very positive mention.

I hope this will help you to see how my own current exploration of <u>free-religion (jiyū</u> <u>shkyb</u> -or, as we have also been calling it in Cambridge, a creative, free-spirituality"—fits into a still small, but much wider, developing movement of modern, liberal religious thought and practice across the globe.
